

A REPORT OF ACTIVITIES OF SCHOLAR SUPPORT PROGRAMME

2016-17

As per the directions of the New Initiatives in Higher Education, the activities of Scholar Support Programme (SSP) of our college for the year 2016-17 were carried out in an effective manner. The programme for the year was formally inaugurated by our principal, Dr.V.Anil on 4th October 2016 in the college seminar hall. Almost all the participants, faculty members engaging the classes, college council members, Head of all the Departments and the co-ordinator attended the function. The details of the important activities undertaken are noted below.

1. Selection of subjects and faculty members

3. Stationery Kit

All the selected 150 students were given two ball point pen and a college note book costing Rs. 40 each through the use of funds specially allocated for the same.

4. Study Material

The monitoring committee has decided to buy books with the use of funds for study material and issue the same to the students. Accordingly a total of 308 books were purchased through the college co-operative store for an amount of Rs. 45,000 giving equal allocation for all the subjects. The books were issued to all the students as per their requisitions and a proper stocks as well as an issue register were also maintained.

5. General (External) Mentoring Classes

Three sessions of general (external) mentoring classes were arranged with different resource persons in two days. In the first day the programme was formally inaugurated by Dr. V.K.Ramachandran, the principal in charge of the college on 18th February, 2017. Sri.Sujesh.C.P, made welcome speech and Ramya.K, Assistant Professor of Computer Science made vote of thanks. The first and second sessions with 1.5 hour duration each were engaged by Sri.Subeeesh.V.K, Assistant Professor of Commerce, SARBTM Govt. College, Koyilandy and Dr. Ayana.N, Assistant Professor of Microbiology, Sree Narayana College, Kannur. As many as 72 students attended the programme. The classes by both the resource persons were ranked high by almost all the participants.

On the second day, 25th February, 2017, the programme started with the inaugural speech by Dr. V.Anil, the principal of the college. Sri.V.G.Prasanth,

Head of the Dept. of English welcomed the gatherings and Sri. Sujesh.C.P imparted vote of thanks. The third session of 3 hour duration was handled by Dr. Premanand.M.E, Associate Professor of English, Malabar Christian College, Kozhikode. A total of 57 students attended the programme. This session was also highly effective as per the feedback of the participants

I also bring to your notice the following difficulties and suggestions for your kind attention

1. As the clerical work associated with the same is quiet heavy, steps may be taken to make use of an existing office staff in order to carry out the clerical work.
2. As there were delay in starting the classes, it became difficult to complete the entire classes with in the short span of time. Therefore needed measures may be taken to start the same from the very beginning of the academic year by giving clear cut guidelines and stringent directions.

It is to conclude that the programme is a highly useful one for the weak students and therefore sufficient steps may be taken to continue the same with out the present difficulties so as to have a grand success of the programme.
