

Based on the student's feedback on the syllabus, most of the students are satisfied by the syllabus prescribed by the University as it is up to date and provides a platform for higher studies(71%).Most of the students(74.5%) are of the opinion that the syllabus need to be incorporated with new generation disciplines. Majority of them are happy with the CBCSS system and its internal evaluation as they can score good marks compared to the earlier system.86% of the students feel over burdened with the frequent examinations. Half of the students are satisfied with the internal evaluation system. The ICT facilities used in the classroom to deliver the syllabus is 84%. There is a good rating for the library facilities. The highest rating is for the laboratory facilities provided for Science students. Majority of the students opined that the syllabus not caters to better employment opportunities and also that it cannot inculcate social and civic responsibilities in their minds. An overall rating of the syllabus content is good.


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
