Date: 24th & 25th September 2023

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of RSM SNDP Yogam College, Koyilandy, organised a two-day Professional Development Programme on “Innovative Teaching and ICT Tools” on the 24th and 25th of September 2023. The primary goal of this programme was to empower faculty members by introducing them to the latest teaching methodologies and ICT tools that enhance student engagement, facilitate blended learning, and improve the overall teaching-learning experience. The programme was well-received, with active participation from faculty members across departments.

The inaugural session set a positive tone for the two-day programme, beginning with a warm welcome by the IQAC Coordinator, Chandni P M, followed by the Presidential Address by Dr. Shaji Maramveetil, Staff Secretary. The Principal, Dr. Sujesh C P, officially inaugurated the event, emphasising the importance of adopting innovative teaching practices in the digital era. The session was graced with felicitations by Vinod Kumar A, Head of the Department of English, and Dr Merlin Abraham, highlighting the importance of professional development for faculty members. The first session titled, Introduction to ICT Tools for Education focused on introducing faculty members to various ICT tools that can be used in education. The speaker Ms. Joshna M, Assistant Professor & Head, Department of Computer Science provided an in-depth overview of tools such as presentation software, online collaborative platforms, digital whiteboards, and cloud-based learning tools. She demonstrated how these tools can be effectively integrated into classrooms to foster an interactive learning environment. Faculty members were engaged in hands-on activities, using these tools to design classroom activities and assignments.



In the second session, Innovative Teaching Methodologies for 21st Century Learners, the speaker Chandni P M, Assistant Professor, Department of Computer Science highlighted the need for innovative teaching approaches that cater to the needs of 21st-century learners. The session covered various pedagogical strategies, including problem-based learning, flipped classrooms, project-based learning, and inquiry-based instruction. The Second day commenced with a session on Blended Learning and Flipped Classrooms. Hridya G, Assistant Professor, Department of Computer Science provided insights into how blending traditional face-to-face instruction with online learning resources can create a more flexible and student-centered learning environment. She explained the concept of flipped classrooms, where students engage with learning material at home and use classroom time for interactive activities such as discussions, problem-solving, and practical exercises. The speaker also demonstrated the use of various digital platforms to facilitate these methods.

The fourth session elaborated in detail the various aspects related to the topic, Using Learning Management Systems (LMS) for Enhanced Teaching. In this session, Remya K, Assistant Professor, Department of Computer Science introduced the Learning Management Systems (LMS) like Moodle, Google Classroom, and Blackboard. She elaborated on how LMS platforms can be used to create, manage, and deliver online content, assessments, and resources to students. The session also covered how faculty can track student progress, provide feedback, and conduct assessments online using these systems. Practical demonstrations were conducted, allowing participants to explore various features of LMS and understand how they can enhance teaching and learning.

The programme concluded with a valedictory session in which the IQAC Coordinator, Chandni P M, thanked all the resource persons and participants for their active engagement and contributions. The faculty members expressed their satisfaction with the programme, appreciating the relevance of the topics covered and the practical skills gained. - Representatives from participating companies provided insights into their organizations.


- Opportunities for Q&A sessions.



Barcode System of University Exam



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REPORT ON THE FYUGP DISTRICT LEVEL ORIENTATION PROGRAMME




