



**Report on Alumni Interaction Programme Organised by the PG

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
INTERACTION WITH ALUMNI 2023-2024

Chemistry Students (2022-23)**

The Postgraduate Department of Chemistry proudly acknowledges the significant contribution of its esteemed alumnus, **Vyshakh Viswanath N**, in initiating and conducting an online NET (National Eligibility Test) coaching program. Designed specifically for first- and second-year M Sc Chemistry students, this initiative highlights the critical role alumni can play in enriching the academic experience of their alma mater.

Vyshakh, the research scholar at Vellore Institute of Technology, Chennai, spearheaded the coaching program in collaboration with **Sreelekshmi S**, a PMRF Ph.D scholar from the Department of Chemistry, Indian Institute of Technology Bombay. Their combined efforts have provided students with invaluable academic support, complementing regular coursework and equipping them with essential skills for excelling in competitive exams like the CSIR NET.

Programme Objectives

This alumni-driven coaching programme is focused on:

- Strengthening students' academic foundations and problem-solving abilities.
- Equipping them with critical analytical skills required for academic and professional success.
- Offering targeted guidance to complement regular coursework while fostering a deeper understanding of complex topics frequently tested in NET.

Programme Overview

- **Duration:** One year (January 2023 – April 2024)
- **Mode:** Online
- **Schedule:** Twice a week (Saturdays and Sundays) for 1.5 hours per session
- **Subjects Covered:**
 - Inorganic Chemistry
 - Organic Chemistry
 - Physical Chemistry
 - Analytical Chemistry

These alumni have drawn upon their own academic and professional experiences to design an intensive NET crash course tailored to the needs of M Sc Chemistry students.

Programme Highlights

Weekend Schedule for Maximum Participation

To accommodate students' academic responsibilities during the week, sessions were scheduled on weekends, allowing for active participation without compromising regular coursework.

Focused Instruction on Key Topics

The alumni faculty delivered detailed instruction on essential NET topics, with an emphasis on clarifying complex concepts and reinforcing foundational knowledge.

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Alumni Meet (Nostalgia) Report -2024 Department of Physics



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
